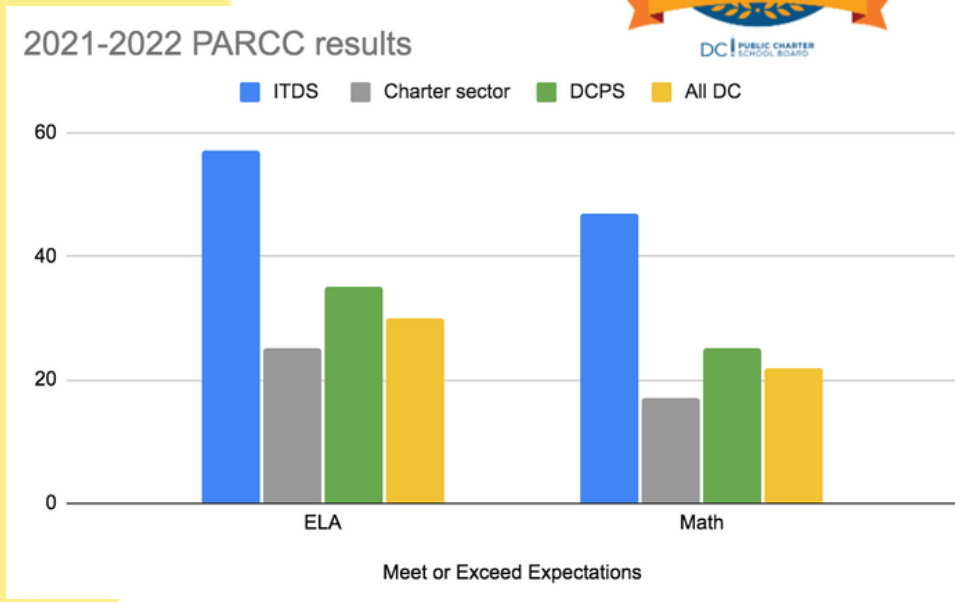

ITDS has consistently achieved Tier 1 status, the highest distinction offered by the DC Public Charter School Board.

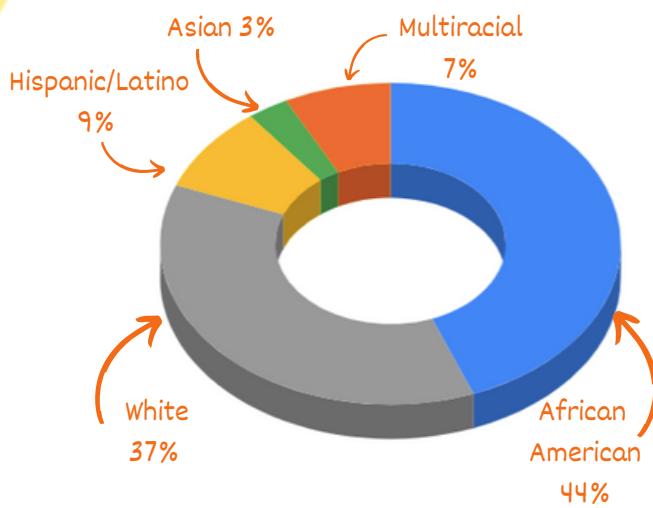
On post-pandemic scores in 2022, ITDS retained its proficiency rates from 2019 and outperformed both DCPS and the charter sector as many schools saw significant pandemic-related declines.
