Nominations and Governance Committee

• Finance & Business Oversight Committee

- Will finish the year in \$10M in cash, reflects savings for a number of contingencies, some of which did not occur
- o 990 has been approved and filed
- Next school year budget has been reviewed, will be approved next month
- o Had annual bond holders investor call last week; went well

- o Items coming up:
 - Basement renovation in summer 2024, \$4M is projected
 - HVAC units still going back and forth re resolving those issues getting to the bottom of the ongoing issues; \$150K fix, compared to the approx. \$400K that's already been spent on interim fixes;
 - Potential of putting solar panels on the roof, to include assessing whether to finance or purchase directly

Head of School updates (Kate in lieu of Dr. Riggins)

- General Updates:
 - o Learning Showcase is June 14, 5:30pm; Board is invited to attend
 - o 8th grade portfolio defenses and promotion coming up
 - Conducted Spring break return to school COVID testing per DCPS recommendation; instances were very low
- Lottery Data:
 - 1286 lottery application, plus 158 post-lottery; 10% increase in apps, compared to 3% city-wide
 - Highest number of apps are in PK3 and 6th grade
- Academics
 - Currently in the middle of PARCC testing
- Fundraising
 - Received a grant of \$66,000 for summer boost program, focus is students who are below grade level as well as incoming students who may need support
 - IFA has been running online auction; Inspired Evening will be less about fundraising, more about community building, particularly for some of the newer families- May 20
- Community
 - Cookies and Conversation will be every Thursday this month for families who can chat after pick-up; Dr. Riggins and Principal Johnson hosting
 - Equity consultant has completed her work, staff will be meeting with her to discuss what the share out will be
 - Request for Kate to send a donation link for Board members to contribute to the school
